

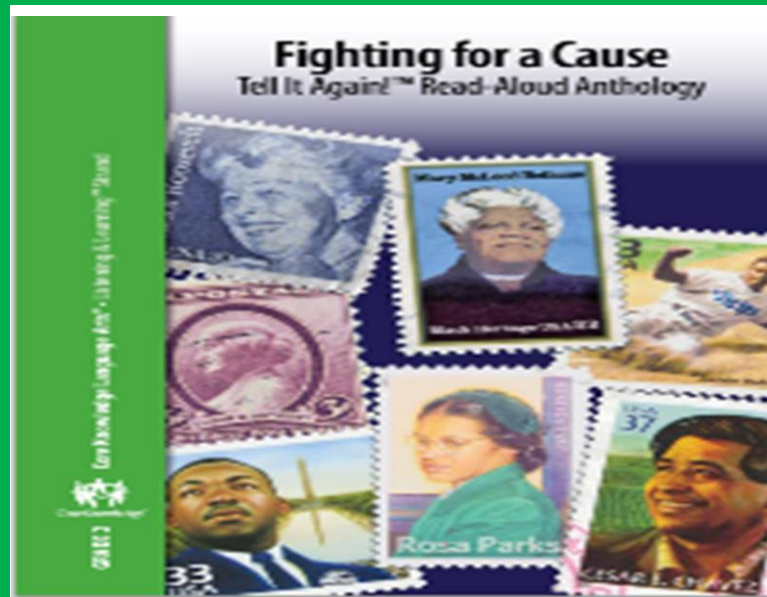
Core Knowledge

- Discrimination means the unfair treatment of a person or group based on traits such as skin colour, race, or religion.
- Fighting for important causes has helped to change laws and improve the lives of many people.
- Know the causes that people might fight for and the reasons they fight for them. (Animal cruelty, pollution, global warming, climate change, Fairtrade)
- The Carbon Light Bulb Filament was invented by Lewis Latimer in 1881, who was the son of escaped slaves.
