

Core Knowledge

- Colours can change your emotions and feelings.
- You cannot make primary colours by mixing.
- Primary colours are red, blue and green.
- You can make secondary colours by mixing two primary colours together.
- Blue + yellow = green
- Yellow + red = orange
- Red + blue = purple
- The warm colours on a colour wheel are yellow, red and orange.
- The cold colours on a colour wheel are blue, green and purple.
- Complimentary colours are found opposite each other on the colour wheel.
